Policy

All medications should be listed on the health history form. Campers may not carry medications with them at camp (with the exception of emergency medications: Epi-pen, inhaler, etc).

Medications should come in their original pharmacy labeled bottle, and a prescriber's order should be obtained at the same time as the physical and vaccine history. Any OTC meds you would like available for your camper can also be sent in an original container with the signed consent form.

Medications will be secured and distributed by camp staff. We will do our best to ensure accommodations for the unique needs of our campers.
